

Adur

Located in the South of the UK near Brighton Adur is a new circuit that was built in 2008, and runs regular 1/8th club meetings. Unfortunately the 2008 BRCA national at Adur was cancelled due to monsoon conditions, so 2009 marks our debut at the Adur circuit.

- **Circuit Directions**

The track is situated on Adur Recreation Ground, roughly 5 miles from Brighton and 5 miles from Worthing. From the A27; follow signs to Shoreham A283 passed the Amsterdam pub, then passed Swiss Cottage pub down to roundabout. Turn right at Bridge Inn on roundabout (over river). First right is the track. Sign says "recreation ground" You must proceed to next roundabout and double back, as you can't turn right. On turning to rec. go over speed humps through car park then through green gate. Track is ahead - 5mph speed limit.

- **Facilities**

You are advised to bring your own table and chair as unfortunately there is no pit area present at Adur. It is also possible to erect tents or gazebos to pit in at Adur. There is refreshments available at the circuit. Mens and womens toilets are available at the track

- **Camping**

Camping is available next to the track but please ask the circuit prior to the meeting regarding camping

Mendip

Built in 1976 Mendip is one of our oldest venues, the circuit has challenging high speed corners and a technical infield, one of the premier venues in the UK. The circuit has previously held the 1/8th European championships in 1990 and is a favourite of many of the drivers. Located in the south west of the UK close to Weston-Super-Mare. Mendip also run regular 1/8th club meetings.

- **Circuit Directions**

From M5 Junction 2. Take the A370 to Weston-Super-Mare, following the A370 for Weston-Super-Mare go through 3 roundabouts, at the fourth roundabout turn left (1st exit) onto Winterstoke Road, go through 1 roundabout. At the next roundabout turn right onto Broadway. At the next roundabout (Weston General Hospital) turn left (1st exit) onto the A370 (Bridgewater Road). As you approach Bleadon, turn right into Accommodation Road, Its sign posted Model Racing Circuit (Brown Tourist Sign). Go down Accommodation road for about half a mile and you'll see the circuit on the right hand side. If you go over a railway bridge you've gone too far.

- **Facilities**

The Mendip circuit has undercover pitting with limited chairs, air compressor, tyre truing area and a limited 240V 13A supply at some pit benches. There is also an on site café that is run by the club which supplies hot and cold food and drinks. Mens and womens toilets are available at the track

Halifax

Located in West Yorkshire, the Halifax circuit in it's current guise has been going since 1999, previously situated further into Halifax the club sold it's track off to a supermarket and was rehoused in it's current location. The Halifax circuit is a big track with a challenging infield section, banked corners and a long fast main straight. The circuit hosted the European Championships for 1/10IC and 1/8th IC Over 40's. Halifax has a thriving club scene that caters for 1/8th cars, and is also available on the PC simulation game VRC.

From M62 junction 24 take A629 towards Halifax, at traffic lights turn left. Immediately turn left again on to Stainland Road. The circuit is situated on the left past the railway bridge.

The Halifax circuit has undercover pitting, air compressor and a tyre truing area. No chairs are available in the pit area. There is also an on site café that is run by the club which supplies hot and cold food and drinks. Mens and womens toilets are available at the track.

The track is located in the grounds of the Philippine craft centre on the A259 between Rye and Brenzett. From London: M20 motorway to Junction 10 (2nd Ashford junction), follow A2070 signs to Brenzett (10 miles). At Brenzett roundabout go straight ahead onto A259 (signposted Hastings/Rye). Past the Little Chef restaurant to Brookland roundabout (1 mile). Philippine Craft Centre is 1 mile ahead towards Rye on the first bend. We are 1 hour from the Dartford Tunnel located on the A259 South Coast road - Midway between New Romney and Rye

- **Circuit Facilities**

Brookland has undercover pitting with pit benches for approximately 120 drivers, undercover drivers stand, aswell as separate area for tyre truing. There is an on site café (not run by Brookland Raceway) which supplies hot and cold food. Mens and womens toilets are available at the track

Wombwell

Located near to Sheffield Wombwell is another of our older circuits. The circuit at Wombwell uses part of the go-kart track for the main straight, this gives a long and wide straight. The infield at Wombwell is probably one of the most challenging in the UK with hairpin bends, fast chicanes, high speed sweepers and carousels. The original design of Wombwell was slightly revised around 2006 making the track around 12m longer than previously.

From The North

Leave the M1 at J37 A628 first exit off roundabout to the lights turn right A6133(Doncaster) stay on A6133 Park Road (Jet petrol station on the right) through the lights onto Cemetery Road signed Doncaster /A1 A6133 at the lights bear right A635 Doncaster Road (Car Wash on right) at the roundabout take the 3rd exit A633 B&Q on your right Wombwell Lane past Tesco on the right (watch for speed camera on opposite side) straight on over the next roundabout (white rose) next roundabout turn left (Railway Pub on the corner) we are on the left (The Track Is Only 6 Miles From The M1)

From The South

Leave the M1 at j36 A61 follow the signs for Doncaster A6195 down the new bypass Dearne valley parkway keep going over the roundabouts (6) following the signs for the industrial estate/ Brown signs with wagon on (not Wombwell) at the 7th roundabout turn left the new B&Q is on the right next roundabout take A633 to Wombwell/Darfield next roundabout turn right BARNSELY DARFIELD next roundabout turn right over the bridge and we are on the left.

If you get stuck just ask for the go-kart track.

- **Circuit Facilities**

It is advised divers bring their own tables and chairs as there are none available at the circuit. It is also possible to erect tents or gazebos to pit in at Wombwell. Mens and womens toilets are available at the track

Birmingham / M5 North

Take junction 11A of the M5, take the A417 to Cirencester. Leave A417 follow signs for Cirencester. Turn right at roundabout & go over bypass, straight over next roundabout. Into 30 limit.

At roundabout take the 1st exit onto Swindon Road (signposted Stroud A419)

At roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Bristol Road - A419

At roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Bristol Road - A419 (signposted Through Traffic)

At roundabout take the 2nd exit onto the A419 (signposted Stroud)

At roundabout take the 2nd exit onto the A433 (signposted Tetbury, Bath, Chippenham)

Approx 3 miles turn left onto minor Rd SP Kemble Airfield.

If Airfield gate is closed either press buzzer & mention Cotswold Model Car Club or call 07739 556597

Keep Airfield fence on right & follow roads to track

London/M4 East Take Junction 15, follow A419 SP Cirencester.

Leave A419 SP Cirencester Industrial Centre, (pass military airfield on left).

At roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Bristol Road - A419

At roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Bristol Road - A419 (signposted Through Traffic)

At roundabout take the 2nd exit onto the A419 (signposted Stroud)

At roundabout take the 2nd exit onto the A433 (signposted Tetbury, Bath, Chippenham)

Approx 3 miles turn left onto minor Rd SP Kemble Airfield.

If Airfield gate is closed either press buzzer & mention Cotswold Model Car Club or call 07739 556597

Keep Airfield fence on right & follow roads to track
